CART started in 1996 with Rotarians in Sumter, SC, voluntarily emptying their pockets and purses of change at weekly meetings. Since then, more than \$8.2 million in grants have been awarded to 45 different research institutions around the United States. We are proud to continue our original mission of 100% of donated funds being designated to research grants.
